

## **Facility Assessments**

- Facility Assessments annually
  - Pre- Post- Data quality improvement projects
- 3 Modules
  - In-depth Interviews supervisors
  - Surveys nurses and midwives
  - Program and Materials Audit supervisors
- 17 countries received grants; 13 reports to date
- Data submission completed except 2 countries
- 2<sup>nd</sup> round data collection July 2017; contracts in June


