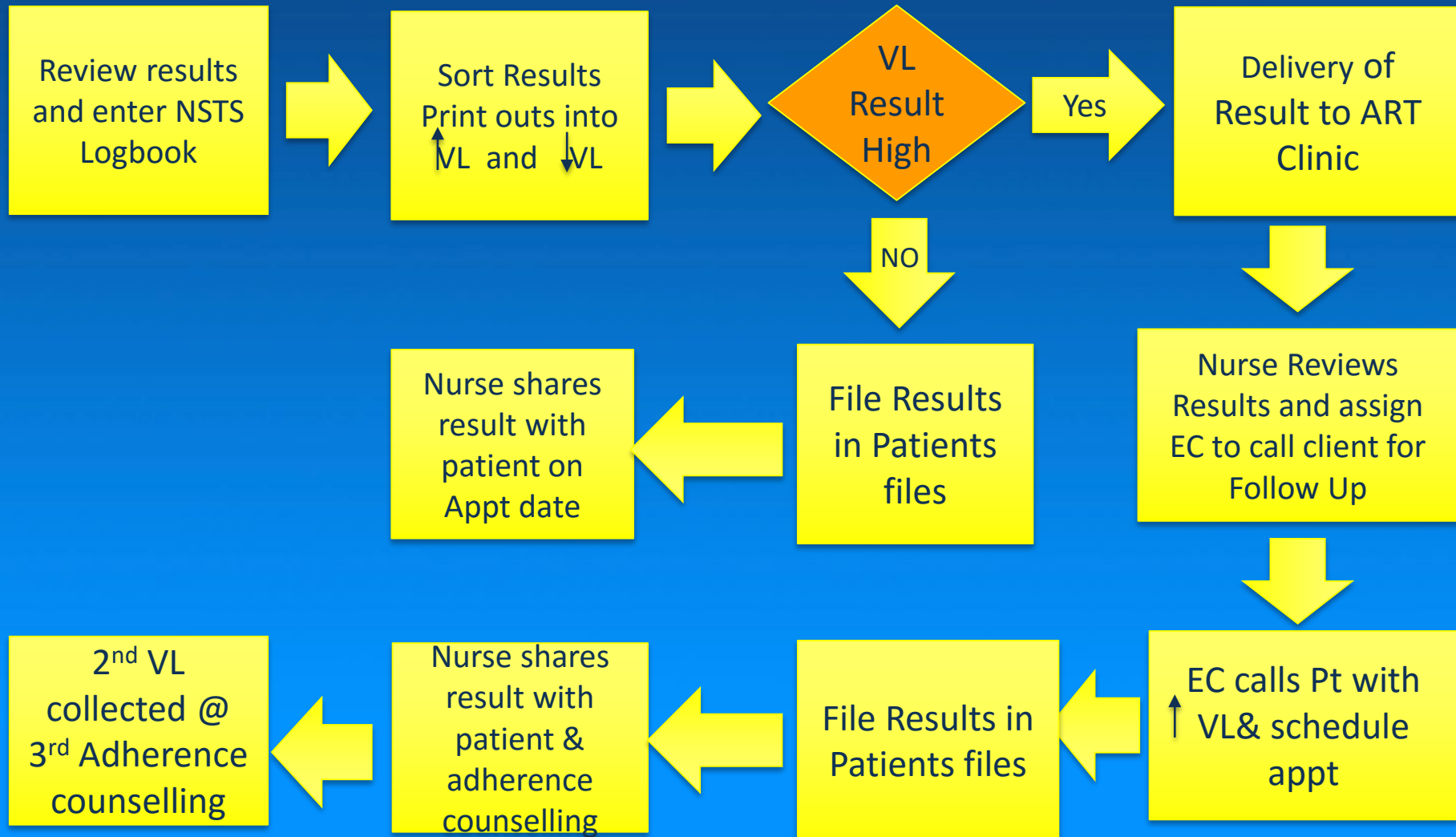


# CAPABILITY MATURITY MODEL
